

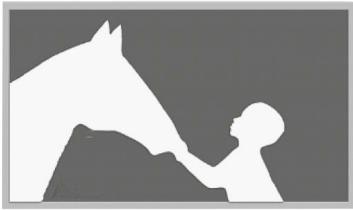

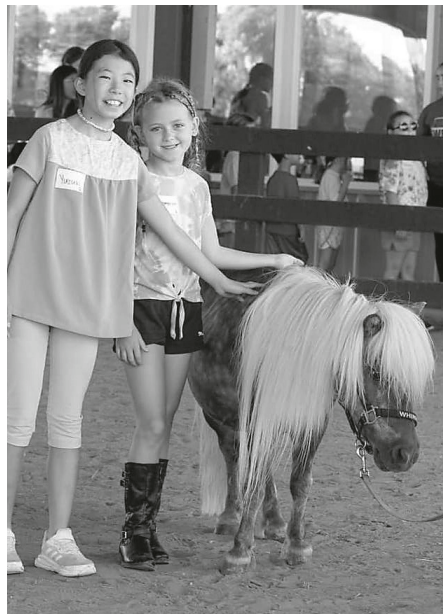

# JUNIOR LEAGUE OF MONTGOMERY

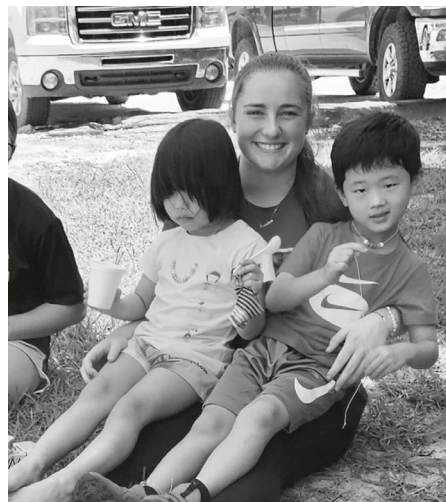
